

Paper Cup devised by Jennifer Collier for Unit Twelve's 'These are a Few of My Favourite Things' exhibition.

**You will need:**

- \*Printer
- \*Photocopiable card (or you can print on paper and draw around this onto card)
- \*Scissors
- \*Glue
- \*Things to decorate, such as felt tips/ washi tape/ found papers/ letter stamps/ sequins/ glitter/ stickers etc

1. Print Template onto photocopiable card, or if you do not have this you can print on paper and draw round this onto card.
2. Cut Out (the handle is optional to include)
3. Decorate – this could be colouring/collaging/ stamping/ washi tape/magazine images/ sequins and glitter etc.
4. Glue the overlap on the rectangle and glue in place to the opposite side.
5. Fold the tabs up on the circle part.
6. Glue these tabs on the OUTSIDE.
7. Push this up on the INSIDE of the bottom of the cup. Then from the inside press to hold each in place.
8. (Optional) Glue on the handle. I glue the TOP of the OUTSIDE and the BOTTOM on the INSIDE of the handle shape, so that you get a nice curve to the handle.

**Variations**

You could look at your favourite makers and take inspiration for their work: We have made some inspired by Lucy Baxendale ([lucybaxendale.com](http://lucybaxendale.com)) by adding monster feet, Duck Ceramics ([duckceramics.co.uk](http://duckceramics.co.uk)) by adding a bright base and a strip matching washi tape to the bottom of the cup. Inspired by Jeff Josephine ([jeffjosephine.co.uk](http://jeffjosephine.co.uk)) we have drawn botanical illustrations with felt tips, and by David Ashby ([david.ashby.ceramics](http://david.ashby.ceramics) on Instagram) by decorating with felt tips, crayons and ink stamps and adding the handle.
