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## Paper Collar Project by Jennifer Collier

You will need:

A printer (optional)

Card

Scissors

Crayons/pens/felt tips OR scrap papers to collage

Glue (ANY glue will work)

Button/Needle/Thread (optional)

\*Print this template onto photocopiable card. If you don't have this you can of course just print this, cut it out and draw round it onto coloured/found/recycled card. OR if you do not have a printer you can draw round or trace of a colour from a garment you have at home.

\*Cut out the collar.

\*Colour this in/ collage it/use washi tape/sweet wrappers to decorate it on BOTH SIDES. Use whatever you have to hand and get creative with what you can use as decoration. You can always add to this once it is made up, if you want things a certain way up or in a certain place.

\*With the side you like the most FACE UP, push a soft fold along the dotted line, as indicated on the template. DO NOT fold a ridged crease as this makes the collar too ridged in look.

\*Put glue on the mark as indicated by the buttonholes.

\*(Optional) IF you have a button and needle and thread, you can stitch a button in place here, or simply glue it on OR just draw a button on!

\*Think about adding details like labels in the back or name tapes to personalise. These are great as a keepsake birth/christening gifts with the child's name, DOB and birth weight on the label.
